

## 4 Foot Double

Modified 2015



This waterfall kit can be installed in one day with a 3 man crew. Kit weighs 2,000 lbs; heaviest piece is 240 lbs. 60-80 gpm water flow recommended.


## Left column is for light cords if needed.

Middle column is for 2" plumbing snorkel which is part of kit but not shown here.

Right column is for concrete fill, added strength.



Base Pieces







Set base pieces 1-5 to overhang pool 1-2 inches, #2 wedge can be reversed for a radius app.



Set top basin piece 9 LEVEL, match pipe and lighting columns with lower level.



Use 1-2 inches of mortar for base pieces and 3/4 to 1 inch of mortar for next layer of castings.



Drop PVC pipe in "pipe" column. Note threaded cap to allow pressure test.



Set lower ledger piece 6 with mortar; match up column to column in base piece.



Mortar cap rocks 10 & 11 or use epoxy for less clean-up. Rake joints 1/2 inch after mortar sets.



Concrete pad should be 12 ft. wide, 30" front to back. Dry set base pieces for alignment.



Set upper ledger piece 7; must be level from right to left but not critical from front to back. Set 8.



Connect plumbing at back of base piece. Hide pipe with extra rock provided in kit.
